MESSAGE FROM OUR CEO

Dear Friends,

This past year was a truly transforming one for North Star Reach. Thanks to our tremendously dedicated donors, medical partners, volunteers, staff, friends and family, we realized our dream of opening North Star Reach and giving kids with serious health challenges a chance to experience the joys of a carefree week at camp—at no cost to their families.

Our dream traces back nearly 20 years, traversing such milestones as securing land from the University of Michigan to raising more than \$26 million to fund the design and construction of our year-round, medically-sound camp. Here are highlights from our inaugural 2016 season:

- We served 200 children and 184 family members during three weeklong Summer Camp and four Family Camp weekend sessions.
- In November, we became the ninth Full Member Camp of SeriousFun Children's Network in the United States, passing the Network's rigorous criteria review with flying colors.
- We were the first new residential camp in the state in 20 years to be awarded a Michigan State Camp Residential License.
- 217 program and medical volunteers fueled our magical first season donating more than 26,948 hours of service.

The difference we're making in young lives is possible because of the support we've received from each of you. As we expand our programming in 2017, hundreds more children who ordinarily wouldn't have the chance to come to camp will soon join us at North Star Reach for transformational weeks of fun, friendship and laughter. We're just getting started!

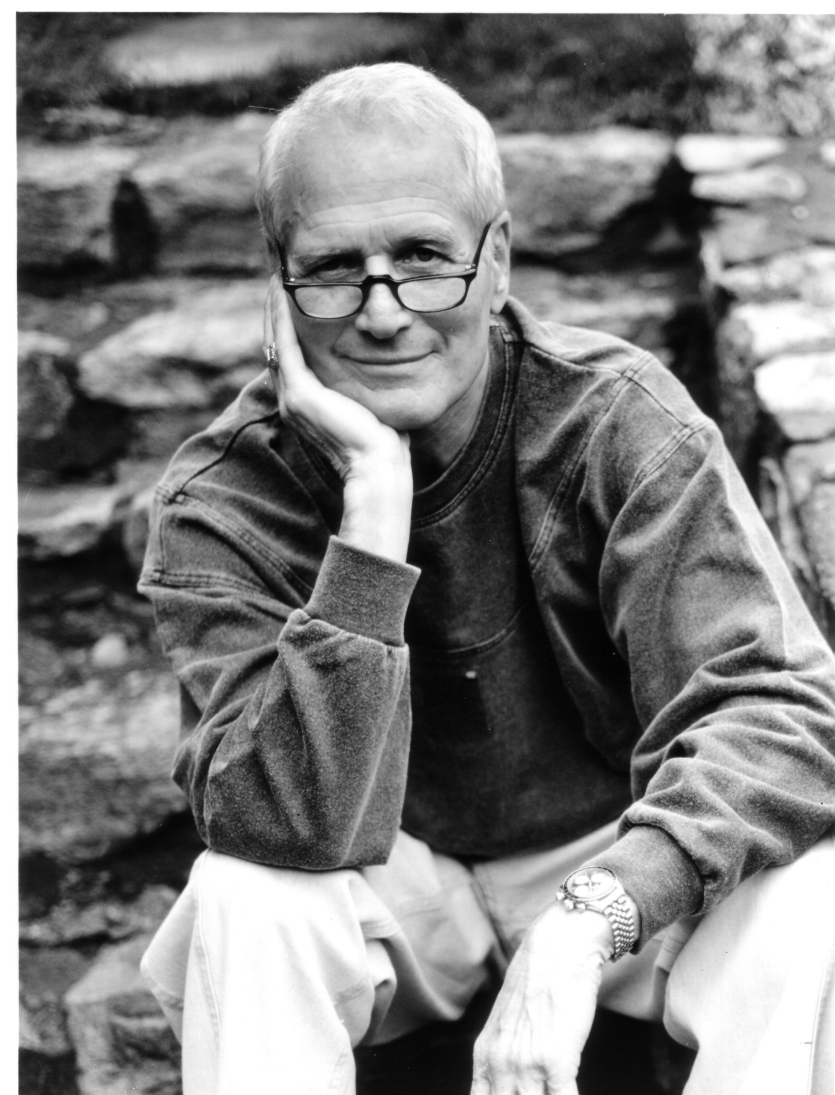

SeriousFun Children's Network FULL CAMP MEMBER

On November 3, 2016, North Star Reach was accepted as a Full Member Camp of SeriousFun Children's Network, one of the world's largest communities of camps and programs for children living with serious illnesses. Founded by Paul Newman almost three decades ago, the first camp began as a place where kids could escape the fear and isolation of their medical conditions and, in his words, "raise a little hell." His vision inspired a global community of independently managed and financed camps and programs. North Star Reach is the ninth SeriousFun Full Member residential camp in the United States.

As a Full Member, North Star Reach benefits from access to technical and program, fundraising, and promotional support from SFCN. With a voting seat on the SFCN Board of Directors—held by 2017 NSR Chairman of the Board Steven Berger—North Star Reach will play a role helping inform future policies and strategies.

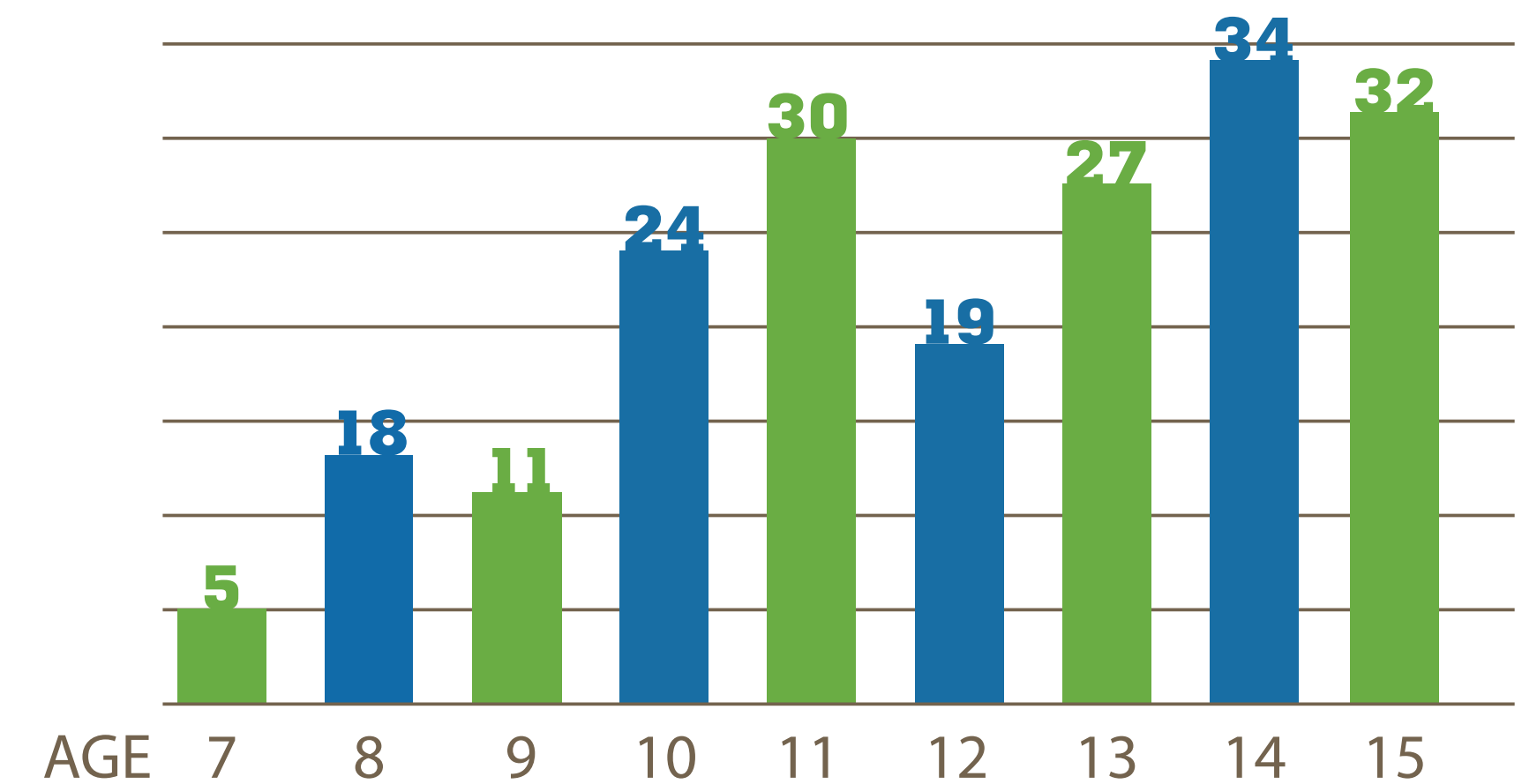

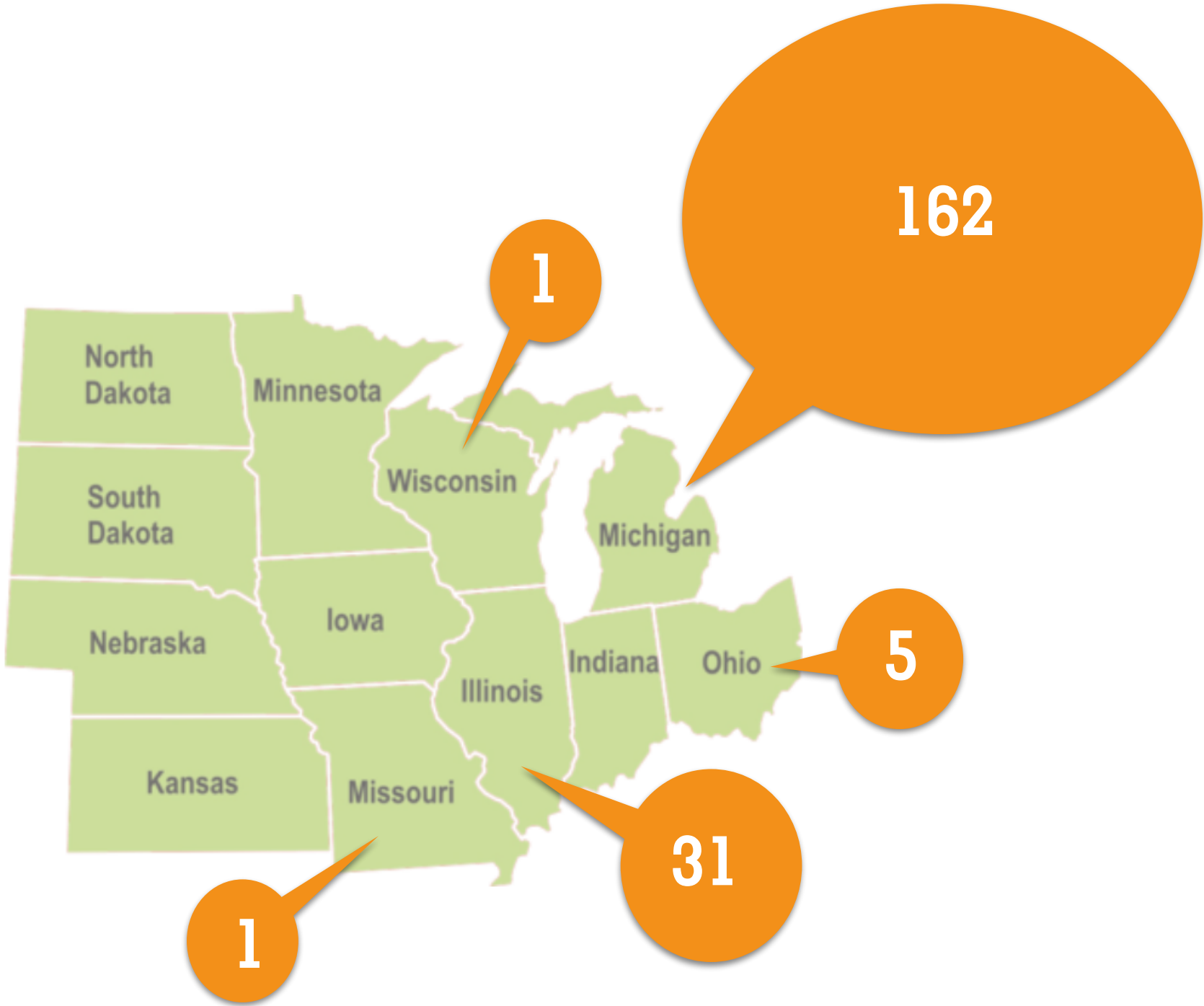

We hosted nearly 50 families during four Fall Family Camp Weekends, including sessions dedicated to families with a child who has received an organ transplant and heart-related conditions.

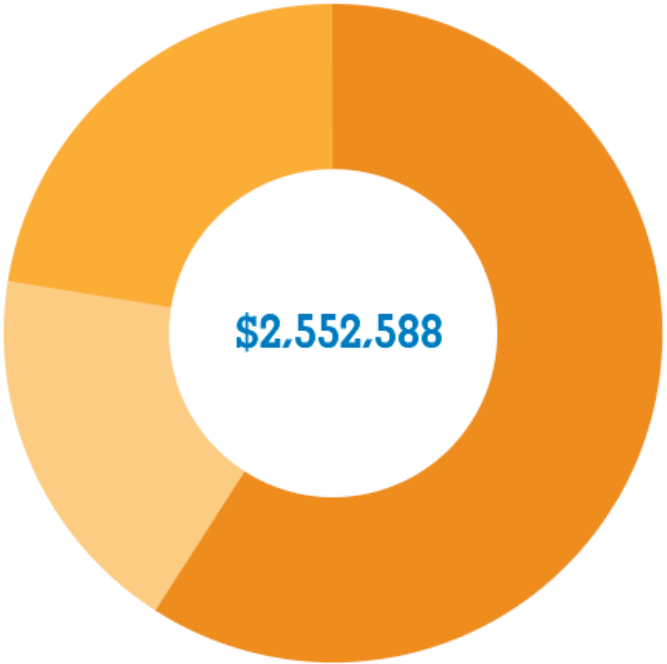

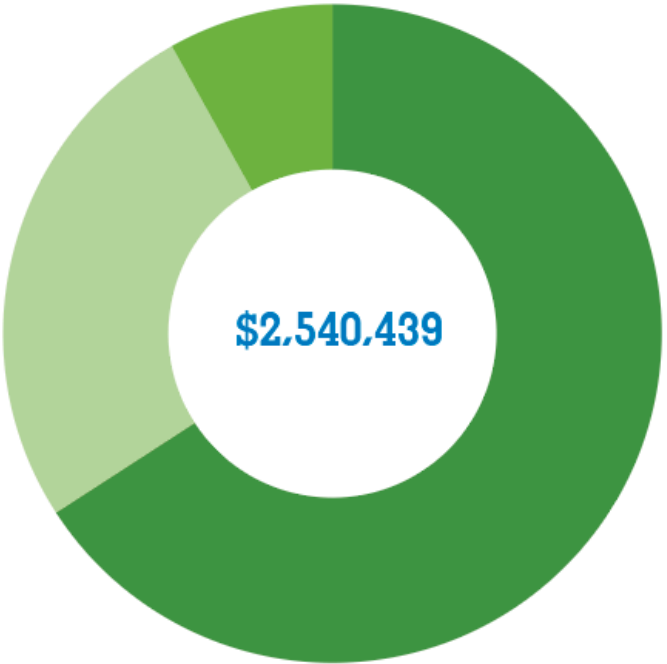
